**Rally Week 2019  
RCC's Annual Cancer Fundraiser

This year's theme for RCC's popular cancer fundraiser, its twenty-first year, is **The Cure is in the Cards**.

RCC Women's Leagues will participate in a Rally event on **Wednesday, August 7, 2019**. The event costs \$10 (women playing in both AM and PM leagues may register twice for \$20, writing names on two lines on the registration form) with half the registration money funding the event. Participants can win two gift card pins (for longest putt, and closest chip) on Hole #7. The third prize is a drawing among all AM and PM Rally participants for an anniversary basket containing theme items. In addition, there will be 12 pink baseball hats donated by David Priebe, as door prizes. The remaining half of the registration fee benefits the local James Beck Cancer Center and will be added to the money raised by the raffles. Participants wearing pink qualify for a special drawing in both AM and PM leagues. **SIGN UP ON THE BULLETIN BOARD after Guest Day.**

**Also on August 7, (10:00 am-7:00 pm), the popular Women's League Basket Raffles** are held. RCC members donate the items and league volunteers sell raffle tickets (3 tickets for \$5; 9 for \$10; 25 for \$20). Examples of articles raffled in the past are: decorative containers with golf, kitchen, wine, or garden items; paintings; certificates for massages, manicures, pedicures, and haircuts; spa products and jewelry. **Please support this worthwhile cause, either by participating in any one of the raffle activities or donating raffle items.** Contact Julie Bronson, events coordinator, (715-369-9007) **ASAP** to donate raffle items.

**In addition, on Tuesday, August 6 and on Thursday, August 8,** during both couples leagues and all men's leagues respectively, a **50/50 Putting for 21 Contest** will be held. Participants donate \$5 (maximum 3 entries totaling \$15) to putt three (maximum 9) balls at six target holes. Two white balls are worth 10 points each and the pink ball is worth either one point or 11 points. Players try to get 21 points. For example, if the pink ball goes in any hole it can be counted as 11 points. Then one more white ball in any hole will equal 21 and is a winner!. Or two white balls holed will be 20 points and if the pink ball goes in, it can be worth one point for 21 and a winner! All players scoring 21 will share 50% of the pot for each contest. If no one scores 21, the highest score will win. (Ties, will split the prize). Money will be awarded Tuesday and Thursday around 6:00 p.m.

The **Straight Shooter 50/50 Raffle** is also held during Men's Leagues. Participants buy three tickets for \$5 on Hole #4. Participants whose drives stay in the #4 fairway receive double (6)



tickets. Drawing is that same Thursday after the last league team tees off from Hole #4. There will be three winners.

All funds raised during Rally Week stays local. RCC has donated well over \$25,000 to local cancer programs. **Join us, have fun, and as always, many thanks for your support during this meaningful week.**
